

**Regulations of the sixth Prof. Jerzy Jakubowski Competition for the best master's thesis concerning arbitration and mediation issues**

- 1.** The competition is open to anyone studying at a Polish university who took their master's degree examinations in **2011-2013**.
- 2.** A master's thesis can be submitted by its author or supervisor.
- 3.** A thesis can be entered for the competition by sending a copy of it in printed and electronic form to the competition's secretarial office (the Court of Arbitration at the Polish Chamber of Commerce, 00-074 Warsaw, ul. Trębacka 4 with the annotation "**Competition**").
- 4.** An opinion given by the examiners and a certificate from the appropriate university confirming that the thesis was defended in a particular year should be attached or enclosed together with the thesis.
- 5.** The deadline for entering a thesis for the sixth competition is **31 January 2014**.
- 6.** Theses entered for the competition will not be returned.
- 7.** The thesis must also include consent to have personal data processed and to use parts of the thesis to promote the competition and its prizewinners, as well as an address for correspondence and a contact phone number.
- 8.** The competition's jury will be appointed by the Arbitral Council of the Court of Arbitration at the PCC, which will determine the prize pool for the competition. The jury will determine the way in which the prizes are divided.
- 9.** Minutes of the jury's meeting will be taken and signed by all members of the body.
- 10.** Prizewinning theses will be included in a book on the sixth competition, published by the Court of Arbitration at the PCC.
